Community Service Programmes

Transportation of Children with disability to the Government Day care Centre. Coonoor

Project "Off To School" was Inaugurated by the Nilgiris Collector, in Coonoor to transport differently abled Children, a total of 115 kms daily to the Government Day care centre for treatment and education. This saw an increase of 80% attendance.















Community Service Programmes

Medical assistance and camps

Children were taken to Speciality hospitals for various consultations, medical diagnostic tests, consultations, operations and physiotherapy.

Monthly medical aid for patients.

Prosthesis, paediatric and spectacle camps was organised.

Environment care

A campaign for conservation of Oil & Natural Gas was organised.

Shop keepers and vendors sensitised about the disadvantages of plastic carry bags. Encouraged them to sell their products in cotton cloth bags made by the women trained by us in Coonoor.

A young student, social entrepreneur producing solar lamps by special children assisted by distribution to remote villages.

In keeping with the principal that every human deserves a dignified send off, we assisted with the last ceremonial rights of 5 unidentified bodies in conjunction with the Local authorities.

Flood relief in Kerala and Kodagu

August 2018 saw the worst floods in history of Kerala and Kodagu. Kinder Trust and WZO Trust swung into action together.

More than 1800 families were assisted with a months ration.

Provisions by the tons, clothing, vessels, mosquito repellents, toiletries, disinfectants, mops/buckets, solar lamps, mattresses and household items were distributed to the affected people.

6 free medical camps were conducted at different locations. An epidemic was averted in a village by providing preventive medication to all the inhabitants.

































Community Service Programmes

Rehabilitation for Flood affected

After distributing aid there was a need to counsel and rehabilitate the people who had lost their farms and homes.

In Mancombu Kerala, a tailoring cooperative with 20 women was initiated. In Aluva 25 women were assisted with machinery to start book making society to earn a livelihood.

Farmers in Kodagu, assisted by an environmentally friendly Bee keeping project NECTAR FLOW as an alternate form of livelihood.
