Community Service Programmes

Transportation of Children with disability to the Government Day care Centre. Coonoor

Project "Off To School" in Coonoor, transports differently abled children, to and from the Government Day care centre covering a distance of 115 kms daily for treatment and education. This initiative saw an increase in attendance of 80%.















Community Service Programmes

Medical assistance and camps

Monthly medical aid for patients in the form of medication, bandages, pampers, & homeopathy.

Camps for assessment and distribution of prosthesis were conducted in Coonoor together with Freedom Foundation.

A Cerebral Palsy screening camp was conducted in Ooty, Coonoor and Kotagiri for medical diagnostic tests and counselling. 70 children were screened out of which 5 children were found suitable for corrective surgery and were taken to a Speciality hospital for corrective surgery and rehabilitation physiotherapy.































Community Service Activities

Skill Development Centre

A skill Development Centre was inaugurated by the Dist. Collector Smt. Innocent Divya in September 2019. With active support of the District Authorities and the Hubbathalai Panchayat for training People with Disabilities in tailoring, embroidery, knitting, patch work quilting, food preservation, soap making and paper pen making.













In keeping with the humanitarian principal that every human deserves a dignified send off, Kinder Trust assisted with the last ceremonial rights of 2 unidentified bodies in conjunction with the Local authorities.

Community Service Programmes

Rehabilitation for the 2018 Flood affected.

In continuation of the project "Nectar Flow" initiated with WZO Trust in 2018, 100 additional new bee boxes were distributed to a different set of farmers in Coorg, who had also been badly affected by the floods of 2018. A total of around 300 kgs of honey, bee wax and bee colony sale, brought in considerable revenue to the farmers. Apart from revenue, there was significant improvement in the bee population, thus improving the environment and also increasing coffee pollination by 40%.

In Kerala, an automatic book cutting machine was provided to Alware Press. (Friendship House) to enhance the production capacity of book binding, providing jobs and income to 25 women who were affected by the Kerala Floods in Aluva.
