About TRAVI



TARVI - A training and resource centre for visually impaired supported by MICROLAND Foundation was inaugurated on the 1st of April 2023. This centre was launched by the Collector of Nilgiris, Thiru S. P. Amrith IAS. The centre aims to impart skill training and livelihood opportunities for visually impaired persons. Computer training is provided through the use of non-visual desktop access or NVDA which is a free screen reading software which enables people with blindness to use computers.

Objectivies of TARVI

As part of skill training that will provide livelihood opportunities for visually impaired persons, courses in computer training, basket weaving are being conducted. Gradually courses in music training, reflexology and facial massage will be introduced.











Course Contents

Computers training includes – basic computer concepts, MS office applications (word, excel, outlook and PowerPoint) Internet – browsing, mailing and data sourcing Assistive technology/ devices English training – Skills (spoken and written) emphasis on error free writing. Projects on employability – helps the overall development of the candidate. Life skills – social competencies, overcoming disability, managing conflicts, effective work habits etc.

Course Format


Supplied, evaluated and examined by National Association for the Blind - Karnataka. Duration of the course is 4.5 months, starting with one month typing, listening comprehension, reading comprehension, spellings, mobility, awareness of assistive aids and work environment. Basic computer skills with English communication, mobility, employability and life skills

Free accommodation with food and transportation is being provided during the training course as well as assistance in employment for eligible candidates based on their performance

Most recently, on September 14, 2024, he took another step towards his goal by writing the TNPSC exam.



Soniya, from Ooty, has low vision, but her determination has led her to achieve remarkable success. After completing her Bachelor of Arts degree in History, she joined the Tarvi Centre's second batch in 2023 to receive basic computer training. With our support, she was able to explore various job opportunities. He holds a Ph.D. in Music and runs his own music academy, TEESHA MUSIC ACADEMY, in Ooty. Additionally, he works as a music teacher in schools. In 2023, he joined the Tarvi Centre's second batch to receive basic computer training. Following his training, he was presented with an opportunity to teach computer classes to visually challenged students in Coimbatore. He now dedicates his weekends to teaching this class. His musical talent was recently recognized when he received an award from the Collector for achieving First place in Vocal Music in The Nilgiris on July 1, 2024



Ismail, from Thrissur, Kerala, was born with visual impairment, but his indomitable spirit has driven him to achieve remarkable success. Holding a Bachelor of Arts degree in English Literature, he is also a talented cricketer, representing Kerala State's blind cricket team. After completing his degree, Ismail worked as an assembler for six months. In 2023, he joined the Tarvi Centre's second batch to acquire basic computer training. Following his training, he received a job offer from Sutherland Company but declined due to salary constraints. Undeterred, he shared his skills as a computer trainer for seven months. Currently, Ismail is pursuing Teacher Training Course (TTC) in Thrissur, further enhancing his career prospects
